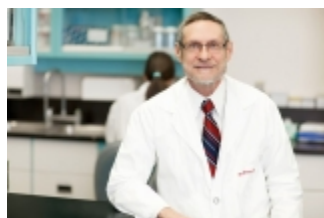
#### *Dr. Sylvain Chemtob receives the Michel-Sarrazin Prize – 2019*
