*"Reflecting on the Contribution of Psychiatry
to Medicine and Health Care"*

Dr. François Lespérance completed his residency program in Psychiatry with a consultation-liaison rotation at the Montreal General Hospital including research training under the supervision of Raymond Prince, MD and Nancy Frasure-Smith, PhD. He continued his collaboration with Dr Frasure-Smith to develop a successful, internationally renowned, multidisciplinary research program on depression and heart disease centered at the Montreal Heart Institute.

Since 2004, in addition to his research activities, he assumed leadership positions and administrative responsibilities. He was the Chief of Psychiatry at the CHUM from 2004 to 2010, navigating through the ups and downs of the Plan d'action en Santé Mentale and the effects of the CHUM merger. He was the Associate Vice-Dean for Clinical Research at the Faculty of Medicine of the Université de Montréal between 2009 and 2011. Finally, from 2011 until recently, he was the Associate Director General for Medical and Academic Affairs and Director of Professional Services at the CHUM.
