Position description

The Department of Psychology at McGill University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position, commencing August 1, 2022. Exceptionally qualified candidates may be considered at the Associate Professor or Full Professor level.

We are looking to expand our department's strength in scholarship related to the areas of race, racism, prejudice, and Black experiences and welcome applicants whose research focuses on these issues in any geographic location. All research methodologies are welcome. The candidate should have an active research agenda and will join an active core of researchers already examining intergroup relations and prejudice in the Clinical, Health, and Social areas of the department. In addition to research, the successful candidate will teach classes and supervise students at the graduate and undergraduate levels. Preference will be given to Black scholars.

This position is part of McGill University's [Action Plan to Address Anti-Black Racism](#), which among other objectives includes substantial efforts to increase the proportion of Black faculty. The department is committed to supporting the selected candidate.

Job Duties

The candidate will be actively involved in all aspects of McGill's academic mission (research, teaching, supervision of graduate students, and involvement in academic and administrative committees).

Research; teaching; academic service.

Qualifications and Education requirements

- 1) A PhD in Psychology or in a related field is required; those who expect to receive their PhD by the start of the position are also eligible;
- 2) A strong emerging record of publications and independent program of research is also required;
- 3) Experience in teaching as lecturer or teaching assistant is beneficial.

The language of instruction at McGill is English; however, a working knowledge of French is a helpful but not necessary asset.
