Minor Program Psychology Faculty of Science

Students are required to complete 24 credits in Psychology, of which a maximum of 6 credits may be applied towards the major (faculty or honours) program requirements. This is referred to as "overlapping credits". The prerequisite course in Introductory Statistics is not included in the 24 credits required for the minor program.
