### Mission:

The mission of the Peter-McGill Community Council is to bring together and promote collaboration between the district's residents, businesses, workers and students, as well as the organizations that serve them. The Council aims to foster a sense of belonging to the neighbourhood and encourage active involvement in community life by creating a place where stakeholders can express their concerns, collectively determine priorities for action and feel empowered to improve quality of life in the neighbourhood.

### Project and tasks description

*The intern would function as an on the ground agent for the food security committee. The student will be asked travel between some of our major food groups in the neighborhood to help with the management and the activities at one of our local community kitchens, help with the main and mobile farmers' markets (the mobile markets being held directly in seniors' homes to avoid potentially difficult displacements), and may be occasionally asked to help with food services in our soup kitchens/shelters. This will allow the student to get a big picture of extreme food insecurity in Peter-McGill, to help create a coherent resource map for our community, and to identify some of the gaps/needs that are not being met by existing services.*
