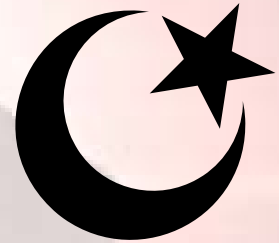

Prof. Ian H. Henderson – Ian H. Henderson is Associate Professor of New Testament and Early Christianity in the Faculty of Religious Studies, McGill. His research interests include Mark's Gospel, the Historical Jesus, and all aspects of Greek and Roman religious rhetoric. Professor Henderson is also a founding member of Montreal's inter-university *Centre de formation et de recherche en traduction et exégèse de la Bible*.
