McGill University is on land which long served as a site of meeting and exchange amongst Indigenous peoples, including the **Haudenosaunee** and **Anishinabeg** nations. We acknowledge and thank the diverse Indigenous peoples whose footsteps have marked this territory on which peoples of the world now gather.

Montréal, also known as Tiohtiá:ke "where the people split or parted ways", is the unceded territory of the Kanien'kehá:ka "people of the flint" who are one of the six Nations of the <u>Haudenosaunee</u> <u>Confederacy</u>.

The Anishinabeg know this land as Mooniyang.








- Sustainability Projects Fund (SPF)

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

McGill Indigenous Tuition Initiative



- Developed collaboratively, lead by the Office of Indigenous Initiatives McGill
- Phase one announced June 2024 and implemented Fall 2024
- Responds to McGill's Call to Action #13- "Implement a student funding model similar to the Haudenosaunee Promise at Syracuse University, which provides tuition and mandatory fee waivers for Indigenous learners from proximate territories."
- Provides the equivalent of tuition and mandatory fees to eligible Indigenous students
- Phase one prioritized local, proximate communities: Kahnawà:ke (QC), Kanesatake (QC), Akwesasne (Ontario, QC, & USA), Six Nations of the Grand River (Ontario)*
- Phase one also prioritized communities in educational partnerships with McGill
- Currently, phase one includes approximately half of all Indigenous learners at McGill (including on-campus and off-campus)
- Phase two is currently being developed


