

Restricting Registration

The best method for restricting CRNs to certain students depends on the situation.

- Minerva notes: Always a good idea Some are automatic
 NOTES: This section must be taken with a laboratory.
 NOTES: Waitlist opens in June. Held in Room F1, Durnford House, 1597 Pine Avenue W.
 - **Reserved seating**: Often generates emails; avoid whenever possible
 - Waitlists: mcgill.ca/students/courses/add/waitlisting
 - **Course restrictions**: Reliable and relatively simple to manage
 - Special approval: Good for small-enrollment CRNs
 - Prerequisites/corequisites: Generally reliable and easy to override
 - Common registration errors: mcgill.ca/students/courses/add/problems



WHAT WE DO

- Provide immigration advice to international students on temporary Canadian immigration and administer the international health insurance (IHI) plan.
- We provide virtual and in-person appointments for students and their dependents on study related immigrations matters (CAQ, Study Permits, Co-Op work permit) and the Post-Graduation work permit.
- We do not advise on Permanent Residency, other work permits or US immigration.
- We organize programs and events that support many social events for International Students during their academic journey

GOOD TO KNOW

- Online platform for students and staff to contact our office.
- Last academic year ISS handled over 12K service requests via the platform; Had 2261 appointments.
- NEW: Drop-in immigration advising 5 days a week.
- ISS FAQs immigration and IHI recent updates.
- IHI latest enhancements to the contract:
 - Mental health increase.
 - An out-of-pocket maximum on prescription drugs equivalent to that of RAMQ and a new MBC Drug eCard.
 - A 5% decrease in rates.
- Navigating Healthcare in Quebec webinar
- Buddy Program is put on pause for the winter 2024 term as a result of a transition to a centralized S2 buddy matching portal.
