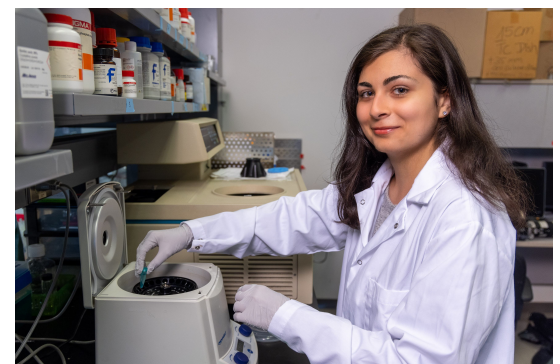


The McGill Biomedical Research Accelerator (MBRA) program

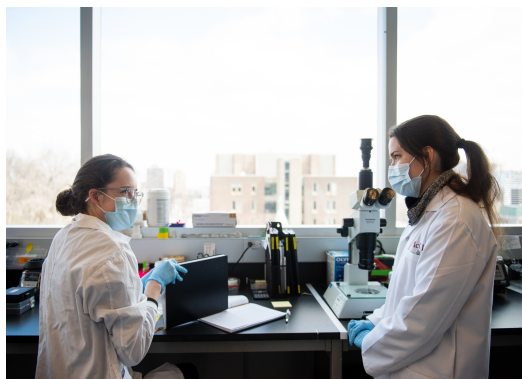
