There is no McGill course that broadly covers the field of ecological restoration. This is a young and rapidly growing field that draws on biogeographical, ecological and environmental sciences. Ecological restoration is of concern to and practiced by government agencies, non-governmental organizations, first nations and private enterprise. As a synthetic discipline ecological restoration informs other sciences, thus will help students of biogeography, ecology and other environmental sciences to increase their understanding of those fields. Some students may use this course as a means to launch or strengthen further study in ecological restoration.
