Josie,

Thank you for replying. I am not completely happy with that wording since our programs do not have elective courses. However, I am assuming from your reply that (as far as the Faculty of Science is concerned) it will be sufficient to bring a motion to Academic Committee to change the note that you refer to. Am I correct in assuming that the approval chain will go as far as the Faculty of Science, but not to SCTP?

I would suggest the following wording for the note, based in part on the Chemistry section of the calendar (where it also applies to MATH 222).

Note: Students entering a program listed below which has MATH 222 (Calculus 3) as a required course and who have successfully completed a course equivalent to MATH 222 in CEGEP (e.g., CEGEP 201-303) or MATH 151 (Calculus B) with a grade of C or better may omit MATH 222 (Calculus 3) from the program, but must replace it with three credits of elective courses.

Of course it will also be necessary to effect the same change in the Faculty of Arts. Does Associate Dean Hendren feel that this change will be problematic?
