EDEM 220 Contemporary Issues in Education will replace, for Minor in Education students, EDEC 247 Policy Issues in Quebec Education, which is focused specifically on the Quebec context, and directed toward student teachers intending to be certified to teach in Quebec. In contrast, EDEM 220 is targeted to Minor in Education students, to provide an introduction to contemporary issues in education in local, national and international contexts. Students will gain an overview of issues in education as they relate to their personal and professional interests as well as a set of analytical frameworks for examining these issues. The course is designed as an 'issues' course that may inspire students to take further courses in the minor, in order to pursue educational issues in more depth. The number of credits of Required Courses is not affected.
