 Re: **Notice of Motion - Proposed Changes to Faculty Constitution**

The administrative reorganization in the Faculty, which involved replacing the position of Associate Dean (Academic & Student Affairs) with those of Associate Dean (Academic) and Associate Dean (Student Affairs), requires a change to the Faculty Constitution in addition to those approved at the Faculty meeting on March 9, 2004.

In accordance with Article 4.1 of the Constitution, notice is here given that the following motion will be brought to Faculty at its Meeting of March 1, 2005.

Be it resolved that the Constitution of the Faculty of Science be amended as indicated in the accompanying table.

2.6 Committee on Student Standing	
2.6.1 The Committee on Student Standing shall consist of eight staff members, other than the Associate Dean (Student Affairs), to be recommended by the Nominating Committee, and four students in satisfactory standing to be nominated by SUS and approved by Faculty. The Chair shall be recommended annually by the Nominating Committee.	2.6.1 The Committee on Student Standing shall consist of eight staff members, other than the <u>Associate Dean (Academic) and the</u> Associate Dean (Student Affairs), to be recommended by the Nominating Committee, and four students in satisfactory standing to be nominated by SUS and approved by Faculty. The Chair shall be recommended annually by the Nominating Committee.
2.6.2 The Associate Dean (Student Affairs) shall respond to all initial requests by students for readmission or for other considerations that the Associate Dean (Student Affairs) has the authority to grant. Students may appeal a decision of the Associate Dean (Student Affairs) to the Committee.	
2.6.3	2.6.3 The Associate Dean (Academic) shall respond to all initial requests by students from other faculties to transfer to <u>the B.Sc. or the B.A. & Sc. Students</u> may appeal a decision of the Associate Dean (Academic) to the Committee.
The Committee shall hear appeals in a manner consistent with principles of procedural fairness and with the Charter of Students' Rights. The hearing process and any modifications thereof shall receive approval of Faculty prior to their implementation.	2.6.4 The Committee shall hear appeals in a manner consistent with principles of procedural fairness and with the Charter of Students' Rights.
