Proposal for UAC approval for ARR handling of new and old SAT results

(to be inserted in the ARR admission standards manual and posted on the application website asap)

- 1. In the admission decision, the results of either the old SAT I or the new SAT I (excluding the Writing component) tests will be considered for September 2005 applicants.
- 2. September 2006 applicants may present: either the old SAT I *plus at least three SAT II subject tests* OR the new SAT I plus at least three SAT II subject tests. Note that certain programs require specific SAT II subjects.
- 3. For September 2006 applicants, ARR will consider the new SAT I (Reading and Math) on par with the old SAT I (Verbal and Math). The required score for the Writing component will be determined in fall 2005 taking into consideration College Board interim recommendations. The ARR reserves the right to modify its handling of SAT scores, particularly during the first few years after introduction of the new SAT I.
- 4. All US high school based applicants applying for September 2007 admission will be required to present results of the new three-part SAT I plus three SAT II subject tests. *As before, ACT results can be accepted in the place of SAT results.*
