Rationale		ENVR 203 and ENVR 400 are both required courses for Environment students. ENVR 203 (Knowledge, Ethics and Environment) is intended to be taken in a student's U1 year. Further, ENVR 203 provides expected background for ENVR 400 which is intended to be taken in a student's U3 year. A certain maturity and depth of knowledge is required in ENVR 400 and when these courses are taken out of sequence, it raises a number of pedagogical difficulties in ENVR 400. This constraint does not apply to Environment Diploma students, who have already an Undergraduate degree. Environment Diploma students are permitted to take the courses out of sequence. Changes have been made from earlier versions to include the Faculty of Ag.Env.Sciences' suggestion to include 'or permission of instructor', and to include the Faculty of Science's suggestion to add the Restriction 'U3 or permission of instructor'.
