Rationale	<p>The course ATOC104/EPSC104/GEOG104 was created to broaden the freshman science curriculum before the B.Sc. program in Earth System Science was approved. The course has been team-taught from the start by these 3 departments, as have the other Earth System Science courses, and it is an appropriate introduction to the Earth System Science program. Renumbering EPSC104 to a single course ESYS104, and retiring ATOC104 and GEOG104 will simplify student registration.</p>					
Course Description	<p>Earth system science examines the complex interactions among the atmosphere, biosphere, geosphere and hydrosphere. It focuses on physical, chemical, and biological processes that extend over spatial scales ranging from microns to the size of planetary orbits, and spans time scales from fractions of a second to billions of years.</p>
