Course Description	This course involves individual research work. Students select a project under the supervision of a staff member. Areas of interest include toxicology, endocrine, developmental, cardiovascular, reproductive and neuropharmacology. This course requires a minimum of 6 hours per week for the full year course (PHAR 599D1/PHAR 599D2), and a minimum of 12 hours per week for the half year (PHAR 599) course to be spent in the laboratory and/or library.	This is a laboratory project course dealing with mechanisms involved in different pathologies and drug actions. Students select laboratories and supervisors and participate in the research activities in these laboratories. A student work is evaluated based on a written report and oral presentation.
