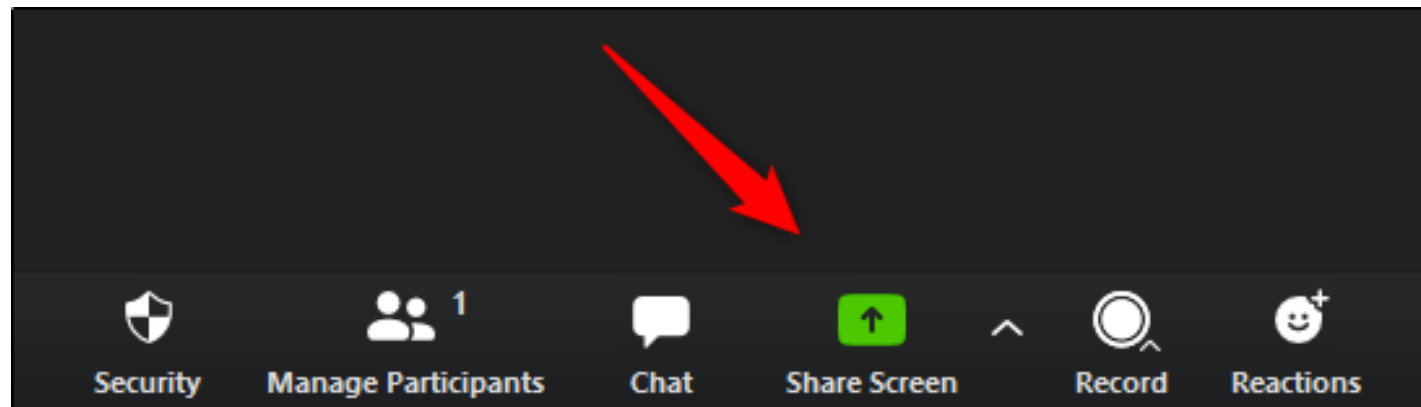

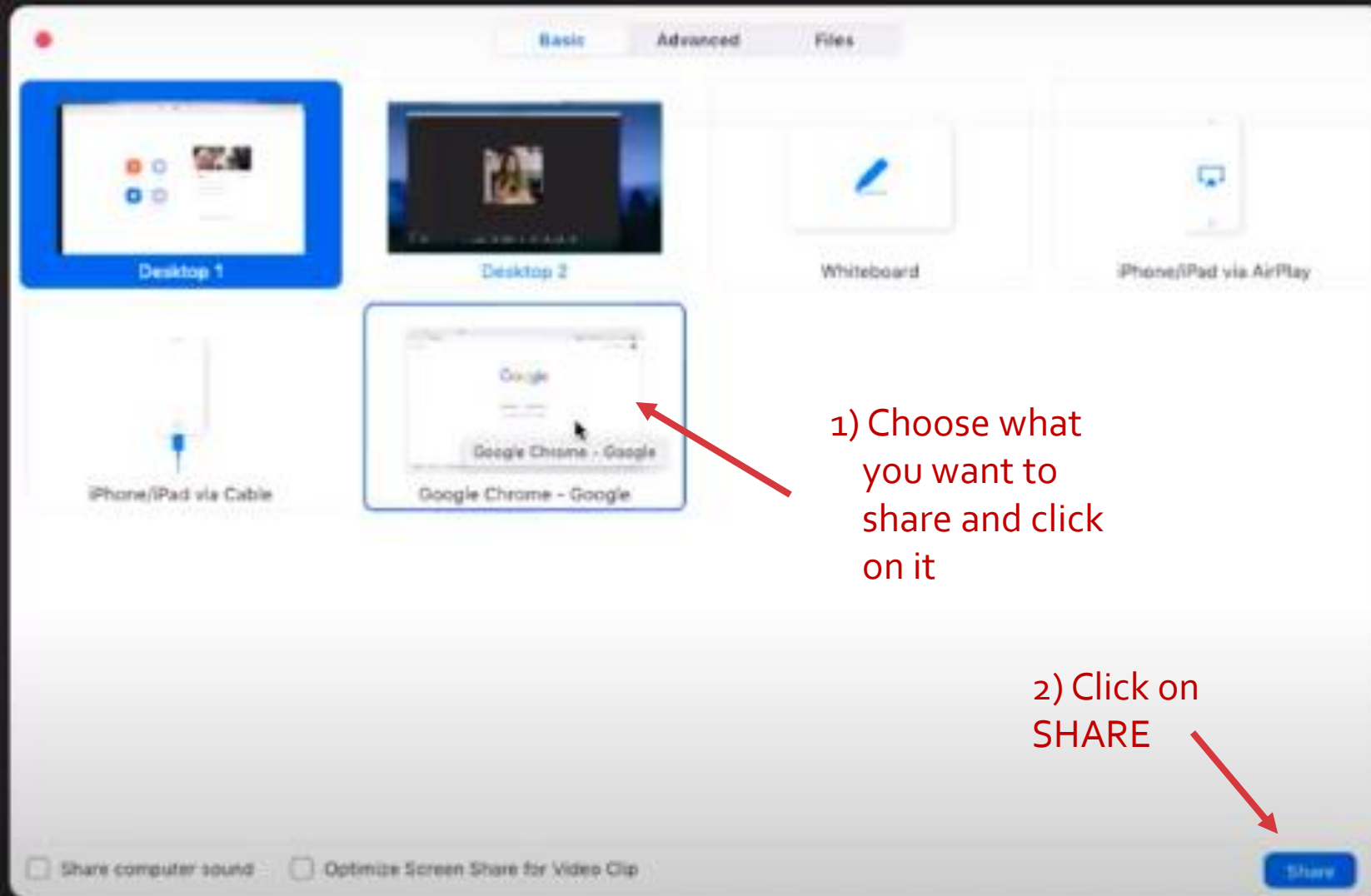
What is screen sharing? What can you use screen sharing for?

- While in a meeting, you can share the following content:
 - Your entire desktop or phone screen;
 - A specific application;
 - A portion of your screen;
 - The Zoom whiteboard;
 - An audio device;
 - The content from a second camera;
 - Your iPhone/iPad screen;
 - A video.

How to use it?

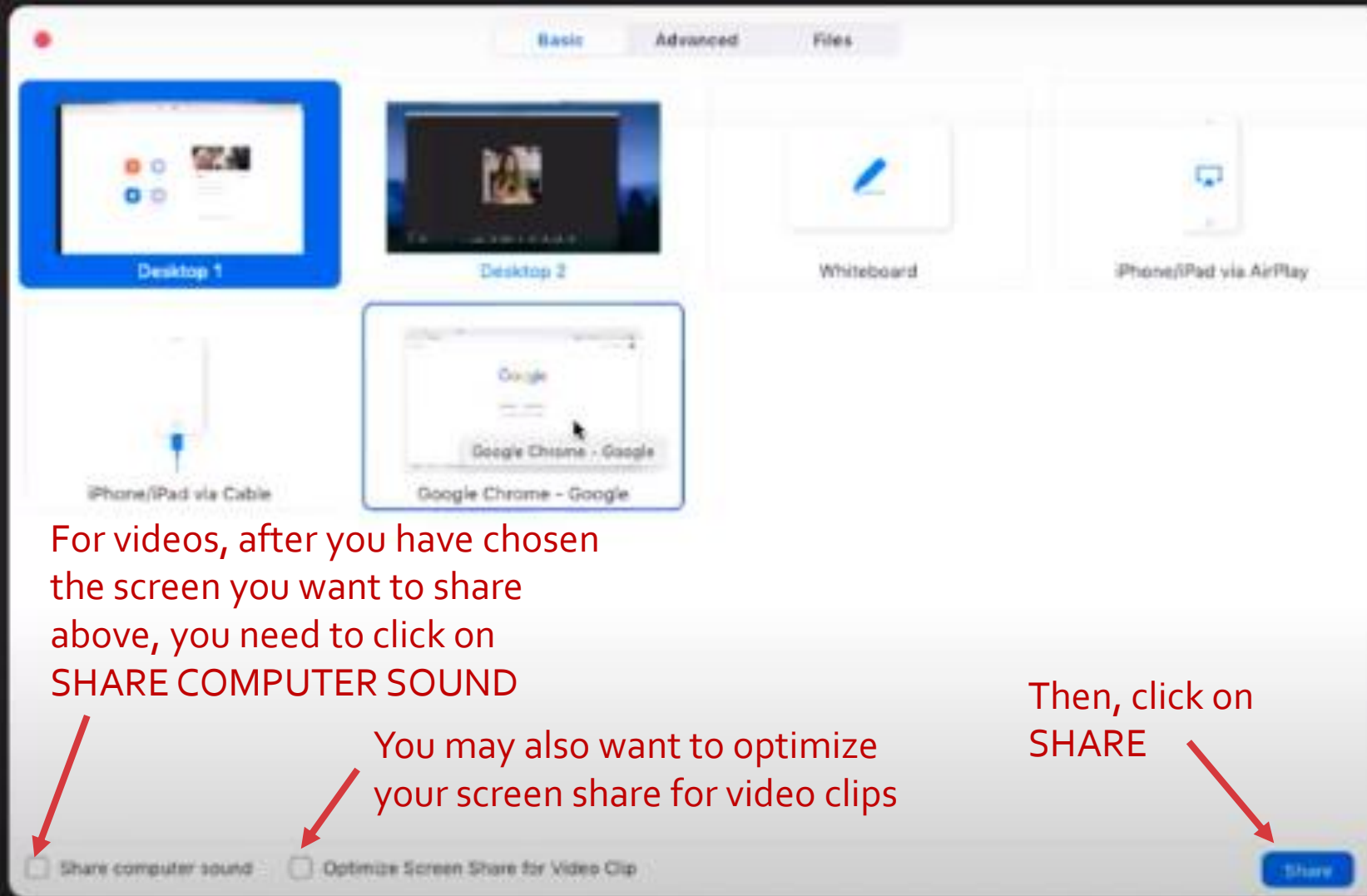
- (1) Open a Zoom meeting on the APPLICATION;
- (2) Click the SHARE SCREEN option seen below;
- (3) Choose the option you wish to use (see next slide).





1) Choose what you want to share and click on it

2) Click on SHARE



For videos, after you have chosen the screen you want to share above, you need to click on **SHARE COMPUTER SOUND**

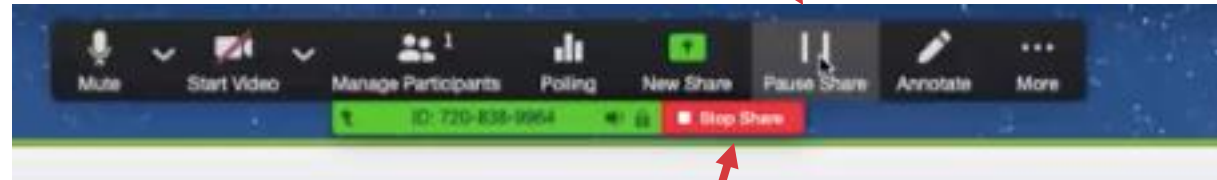
You may also want to optimize your screen share for video clips

Then, click on **SHARE**

If you wish to Pause the video you are sharing,
click PAUSE SHARE.



When you are done and wish to stop screen
sharing, then click on STOP SHARE.

When something is not working properly, or to
move from one screen to another (e.g. moving
from your Power Point slides to a video), it is
usually best to stop screen sharing and to
reopen a new screen share.
