Professors Trehearne and Neilson joined the meeting to present, and respond to questions about, the Department’s response to SCTP’s comments and requested information from the meeting of March 6, 2008. Currently, the course would not be a program requirement, but it is the intention to add the course in the drama performing program; this was the case in the mid-1990’s – the program contained a 3-credit course in performance. Discussion ensued about the need for a prerequisite, but Professors Trehearne and Neilson did not think this was necessary as first-year and freshman students may be interested in taking this course. SCTP commented that students need to attain a certain level of skills before taking this course, to which it was noted that Supplemental Information on the proposal did indicate “Departmental approval required.”

SCTP requested:

- this integrative course should be a 300- or 400-level capstone course;
- course outline be submitted with the revised proposal, as SCTP would like to review how candidates are evaluated and chosen to participate in this course;
- this revised proposal should be reviewed by the Curriculum Committee within the Faculty of Arts and submitted to SCTP.
