The following course and program proposals have been approved by Fiona Lees, Enrolment Services, on behalf of SCTP. **Highlighted text in pink are queries to/information for units.**

### SECTION A: APPROVED PROGRAMS

#### **Minor and Moderate Revisions**

Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences

Department of Plant Science

**B.Sc.(Ag.Env.Sc.); Specialization in Professional Agrology** (21-24 cr.) – description, complementary courses deleted, how complementary courses chosen revised. *Rationale:* To meet the needs of the OAQ.

Faculty of Arts

School of Social Work

**M.S.W.; Non-Thesis** (45 cr.) – elective courses paragraph revised. *Rationale:* Part of description no longer applies. *ES Comments/Corrections:* Only the Non-Thesis program affected – memo revised by the SCTP Secretary.

Faculty of Dentistry

**D.M.D.** (215.5 cr.) – program credit weight increased, required courses added, required course deleted, two required courses' title revised. *Rationale:* Updates to courses; Medicine course becomes exclusive to Medicine students.

**M.Sc. in Dental Sciences** (45 cr.) – complementary courses added. *Rationale:* Addition of reading courses and a research communication course.

**M.A. in Education and Society** (45 cr.) – complementary courses deleted; streams removed; complementary credits decreased; elective credits increased. *Rationale:* Provide more scheduling freedom and allow the development of new courses that better meet the needs and interests of the students.

**M.A. in Education and Society; Non-Thesis** (45 cr.) - complementary courses deleted; streams removed; complementary credits decreased; elective credits increased. *Rationale:* Provide more scheduling freedom and allow the development of new courses that better meet the needs and interests of the students.

**Ph.D. in Educational Studies** (0 cr.) – elective credits increased; how elective courses chosen revised. *Rationale:* To ensure students take at least 3 credits of elective courses. *ES Comments/Corrections:* Effective date revised to read “201509” from “201409”.

Faculty of Religious Studies

**B.Th.** (120 cr.) – how complementary courses chosen revised. *Rationale:* To allow lower-level introductory courses to be taken. *ES Comments/Corrections:* Indicate the program credit weight. It is recommended to be consistent with the University norm and list the program with all required courses together and all complementary courses together. Indicate effective date as “201509”. If this is just a partial listing of the affected section of the program, this needs to be indicated. Revised complementary courses section – it does not add up to 21 credits. Should complementary courses read “24-27 credits”? Should the 6 credits of languages read “0-6 credits ...”?
