#### Minor and Moderate Revisions

Faculty of Education

**B.Ed. in Kindergarten and Elementary Education** (120 cr.) – a complementary course added. *Rationale:* Appropriate content for program, and to give students more choice.

Explanation is needed as to why so many mathematics courses with such loose descriptions are needed. Why not simply offer a single slot course? *SCTP Comments/Corrections:* Remove course title from prerequisite course;

CSCI 101 General Chemistry (4 cr.). *ES Comments/Corrections:* How is content coordinated between the two groups? Rationale is not clear – will lectures be given by Chemistry staff but labs will be at Dawson? How are resources not needed if labs are being out sourced? **NOTE CSO: New subject code;**

CSCI 102 Physics – Science Mechanics (4 cr.). *ES Comments/Corrections:* Is McGill staff teaching the lectures? How is the lab portion coordinated between Physics at McGill and Dawson? How are resources not needed if labs are being out sourced?

CSCI 103 General Biology (4 cr.). *ES Comments/Corrections:* Confirm that McGill staff are teaching the lectures; how are labs and lectures coordinated? How are resources not needed if labs are being out sourced?

CSCI 104 Introduction to Psychology (3 cr.). *ES Comments/Corrections:* Who teaches it? If Chemistry, Biology and Physics are created due to lab space constraints, why do you need a special psychology course? Why not a separate section of PSYC 100?
