Minor and Moderate Revisions

Faculty of Engineering

B.Eng.; Co-op in Mining Engineering (150-151 cr.) – program description, program notes revised. Secretary's comments/corrections: Revise program description to include the focus/subject of the program, remove referral to the other Mining program, and remove specific courses/lectures/laboratories/seminars; revise third sentence to read "... work terms. The program contains two streams: English ..."; delete fourth sentence – this is obvious by the program requirements and revise last sentence to read "... for approval. The program includes student projects that are reinforced by field trips to industrial operations"; revise first requirement following complementary Courses heading to read "17 credits from Stream A or Stream B".

B.Eng. in Mining Engineering (144-145 cr.) – program description, program notes revised. Secretary's comments/corrections: Revise program description to include the focus/subject of the program, remove referral to the other Mining program; revise second sentence to read "... Engineering. The program contains two streams: English ..."; delete third sentence – this is obvious by the program requirements and revise last sentence to read "... of the program. The program includes student projects that are reinforced by field trips to industrial operations"; revise first requirement following complementary Courses heading to read "17 credits from Stream A or Stream B"; revise program notes as was done in the Co-op program.

M.A. in Anthropology (45 cr.) – program description, required courses deleted, required courses added, how complementary courses chosen revised. Chair's comments/corrections: Correct rationale, as it does not make sense related to the changes; ensure all approvals are indicated in box 9; revise effective term to 202209. Secretary's comments/corrections: Indicate existing description in box 6.0; revise proposed description to read "The M.A. in Anthropology (Thesis) provides advanced-level training ... and archaeology. The program culminates ..."; use underlining in the proposed column on all additions and underline only the text that is being revised – revise advisor to read adviser.
