Minor and Moderate Revisions

School of Continuing Studies

Certificate in Indigenous Business Management (30 cr.) – credit weight increased for corequisite course, program note added, corequisite credits increased. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Program note omitted from the existing program requirements under corequisite-course section; remove corequisite program note from existing column, as it is not currently included within the program; underline the added note in the proposed column.

Certificate in Supply Chain Management and Logistics (30 cr.) – credit weight increased for corequisite course, corequisite credits increased.

Certificate in Proficiency in English for Professional Communication (30 cr.) – program description, credit weight increased for the preparatory courses, preparatory credits revised, double asterisks added to complementary-course heading, a program note added, program notes revised. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Confirmation needed as to how, as per revised description, each student takes ten courses in this program; remove the double asterisks from the required-course heading and add them to the complementary-course heading – these notes apply to how many complementary courses are needed.

M.Sc. in Dental Sciences; Non-Thesis (45 cr.) – a required course added, required credits increased, how complementary courses chosen revised, complementary credits decreased.

Ph.D. in Oral Health Sciences (0 cr.) – program description, title revised for a required course, how complementary courses chosen revised, complementary credits increased.

Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences

Graduate Diploma in Medical Radiation Physics (30 cr.) – program credit weight decreased, a required course deleted, a required course added, required credits decreased.
