

REPORT 6 FROM THE ASSOCIATE PROVOST (TEACHING AND ACADEMIC PROGRAMS) TO SCTP

The following course and program proposals have been approved by Associate Provost Chris Buddle, SCTP Chair, on behalf of SCTP. **Highlighted text in pink are queries to/information for units.**

Minor and Moderate Revisions

Faculty of Education

**B.Ed. in Kindergarten and Elementary Pédagogie de l’Immersion Française** (120 cr.) – program notes revised, required-course list subheading added, a required course added. **Chair’s comments/corrections:** The addition of zero-credit courses to programs should not be a pattern – see memo dated November 19, 2020 from the Associate Provost to Associate Deans (Academic) on zero-credit courses; correct title for new course EDSL 501.

**B.Ed. in Kindergarten and Elementary Education; First Nations and Inuit Studies** (120 cr.) – required courses deleted, a required course added, required credits decreased, a complementary course moved from one group to another, complementary-course list subheadings added, complementary courses added, complementary credits increased, elective-course section added, how elective courses chosen indicated, elective credits increased.

**Certificate in Education for First Nations and Inuit** (60 credits) – a required course deleted, a required course added, a required-course list subheading revised, required credits increased, a complementary course added to two streams, how complementary courses chosen revised, complementary credits decreased.

**B.Com.; Major in General Management; Concentration in Managing for Sustainability** (15 cr.) – program description, a required course added, required credits increased, complementary courses deleted, complementary courses added, complementary courses moved from one group to another, how complementary courses chosen revised, complementary credits decreased.

EAST 388 Asian Migrations and Diasporas (3 cr.) [PRN 17630]. Affected programs indicated. **Secretary’s comments/corrections:** Remove the B.A. Supplementary program from list of affected programs – it does not list specific complementary courses; revise description to read “Introduction to the ...”; delete last sentence from rationale;

FREN 253 Œuvres repères de la culture (3 cr.) [PRN 15993]. **Secretary’s comments/corrections:** Two different titles not permitted – Calendar title revised to match the Official title; revise description to read “L’introduction aux œuvres étrangères qui ont marqué durablement la culture et la littérature occidentales. Les œuvres au programme seront étudiées en traduction française”; indicate in the supplementary info box “Cours à contenu variable”; correct administering Faculty to “AR – Arts”;

LING 211 Intro to Indigenous Languages (3 cr.) [PRN 17650]. **Secretary’s comments/corrections:** Revise description to read “Explores the ... century. Many different ...”; obtain a consultation from the Department of Integrated Studies in Education;

LING 411 Structure of an IndigenousLang (3 cr.) [PRN 17651]. **Chair’s comments/corrections:** Revise the prerequisites to indicate the course numbers - not course titles. **Secretary’s comments/corrections:** Official title revised to match Calendar title and abbreviation revised; revise description to remove last sentence and add it to the supplementary info box; indicate “No” for Thesis Component under “To be completed by the Faculty”;

LING 611 Analy of an Indigenous Lang (3 cr.) [PRN 17870]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Revise description to remove last sentence and add it to the supplementary info box; indicate “No” for Thesis Component under “To be completed by the Faculty”;

PPOL 637 Policy Case Study 7 (1 cr.) [PRN 17640]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Indicate program [and its full title] for the affected program within the second box;

PPOL 638 Policy Case Study 8 (1 cr.) [PRN 17641]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Indicate program [and its full title] for the affected program within the second box; remove course number from course title;

PPOL 648 Race, Inequality, & Public Policy (2 cr.) [PRN 17830]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Indicate full program title for the affected program within the second box; Official course title punctuation revised; revise restriction to delete “or other students with written permission ...”, as this course would not be open to other students in regulated programs;

PPOL 651 Sp Topics: Policy Complexity 2 (2 cr.) [PRN 17642]. *Chair's comments/corrections:* Correct Official title to match Calendar title. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Indicate program [and its full title] for the affected program within the second box; title abbreviation revised; revise course title for PPOL 650, via a course revision proposal, to “Special Topics in Policy Complexity 1”.

EDSL 370 Iss&Pracs: Teach Indigenous Langs (3 cr.) [PRN 15708]. Affected program indicated. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* There are no courses specified for the indicated affected program – suggest that this program be revised to list program requirements by listing all specific courses; title abbreviation revised; revise restriction to read “Open only to students enrolled in First Nations and Inuit programs offered by the Faculty of Education”;

EDSL 501 Attestn de maitrise lang franç (0 cr.) [PRN 18042]. Affected program revised and indicated. *Chair's comments/corrections:* The creation of zero-credit courses for inclusion in programs should not be a pattern – see memo dated November 19, 2020 from the Associate Provost to Associate Deans (Academic) on zero-credit courses. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Title abbreviation revised; remove “de la” from Calendar title and update program revision proposal; revise description to read Successful completion of a recognized ... to teach French”; move info on specific programs and test to supplementary info box;

EDEC 321 Visions&Realts of IndigenousEd (3 cr.) [PRN 18026]. Affected program revised;

EDEC 341 Intermed Indigenous HertgeLang (3 cr.) [PRN 18024]. Affected program revised. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Obtain a consultation from the Department of Linguistics; revise effective term to 202109 to coincide with program revision proposal;

EDEC 343 Adv Indigenous Heritage Lang (3 cr.) [PRN 18025]. Affected program revised. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Obtain a consultation from the Department of Linguistics; remove course title from prerequisite course.

FINE 464 Pension Funds & Retirement Sys (3 cr.) [PRN 18072]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Remove from rationale that this is a joint B.Com./M.B.A. course – M.B.A. students will not be able to take this course; correct the course outline to remove referral to the 600-level course – the M.B.A. programs are self-funded programs, therefore, their courses cannot be cross-listed with a similar undergraduate-level course because the B.Com. programs are regulated; the course description on the outline must match that approved on the course proposal;

FINE 490 Mergers & Corp Reorganizations (3 cr.) [PRN 18410]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Revise the description on the course outline to match what is approved on the course proposal form;

MGSC 434 Topics in Operations Mgmt (3 cr.) [PRN 16140]. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Title abbreviation revised; revise restriction to read “Open to U2, U3 students”.

BIOL 610 Scientific Manuscript Writing (3 cr.) [PRN 16032]. *Chair's comments/corrections:* Revise description to read “Guide through the process of writing a scientific manuscript, including how to effectively communicate research findings to maximize their impact, and providing an atmosphere and structure for writing. Expectation that students bring data to the course with a goal of completing manuscript writing including narrative, writing style, effective figures, editing, and peer review.” *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Remove restriction, as the information is already in the prerequisite; if, as per supplementary info, this course may be taken by undergraduates, it should be at the 500 level in order for this course to count towards their undergraduate program credits.

[PRN 17610] – title, description, restriction. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Correct Calendar title to read the same as the Transcript title; as this is a double-prefix course with ARTH 356, a course revision or retirement proposal is needed for the ARTH version;

EAST 377 Topics: Transnat Asian Culture (3 cr.) [PRN 17611] – title, description. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Revise description to read “Investigation of cinema's border ...”; confirmation needed whether this topics course should have slot status;

EAST 389 Global Cinema and Media Asia (3 cr.) [PRN 17612] – title, description. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Title abbreviation revised; revise description to read “Ascendancy of East Asian cinema and ... ”; confirmation needed whether the second-to-last line should read “... and East Asian media platforms”;

EAST 464 Image, Text, Performance (3 cr.) [PRN 17616] – description;

EAST 468 Science and Technology: Asia (3 cr.) [17613] – description. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Confirmation needed whether the revised description should read “History ... and the legacy of non-Western traditions”;

EAST 655 East Asian Poetry and Poetics (3 cr.) [PRN 17614] – title, description. *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Revise description to read “Seminar in East Asian poetry. Topics vary from premodern to modern poetry of ...”;
