B.A.; Honours in Sociology (51 cr.) – program description, a complementary course deleted, complementary courses added, how complementary courses chosen revised. **APB Comments/Corrections:** Revise proposed description to read “... to graduate or professional schools ... CGPA of 3.0.”

M.A. in Economics; Non-Thesis - Development Studies (45 cr.) – program description, required courses added, required credits increased, how complementary courses chosen revised, complementary credits decreased. **APB Comments/Corrections:** Propose a better description, as the proposed does not focus on the subject of the program. **SCTP Comments/Corrections:** Remove from proposed description the other departments involved, as the description for this program should only refer to this program - also omit courses that students will take; indicate existing description as “None” in box 6.0; added required courses should be listed following ECON 634; use strikethrough in existing column for text being revised and use underlining in proposed column for new text; indicate second group of complementary courses as “0-3 credits ...”

M.A. in Economics; Non-Thesis – Population Dynamics (45 cr.) – required courses added, required credits increased, how complementary courses chosen revised, complementary credits decreased. **SCTP**

Comments/Corrections: Added required courses should be listed following ECON 634; use strikethrough in existing column for text being revised and use underlining in proposed column for new text; indicate third group of complementary courses as “0-3 credits ...”

FSCI 398D1/D2 Res Proj: Sci Teach&Learning 3 (6 cr.) [PRN 14301]. *SCTP Comments/Corrections:* Title spacing revised; why is a 6-credit spanned version proposed when students can take two other research project courses [FSCI 396 and 367]?

[PRN 15631] – description. *APB Comments/Corrections:* As per rationale, confirmation is needed whether the prerequisite is being revised also. *SCTP Comments/Corrections:* If the entire prerequisite is to be removed, “None” should be indicated in the New Data column;

ECON 770 PhD Research Seminar 1 (1 cr.) [PRN 16068] – supplementary info;

ECON 771 PhD Research Seminar 2 (1 cr.) [PRN 16069] – prerequisites, supplementary info.

FSCI 396 Res Proj: Sci Teach&Learning 1 (3 cr.) [PRN 15903] – title, restriction. *APB Comments/Corrections:* Why does the restriction refer to the same instructor and the same course (396) – is that not why the other course (397) was created? *SCTP Comments/Corrections:* Title spacing revised; revise proposed restriction to remove referral to “396”, as it does not make sense – indicate instead “two research project courses”; if, as per restriction, students can “continue a project” in FSCI 397, why the need for FSCI 398D1/D2?
