DHUM 690 Digital Human Capstone Project (15 cr.) [PRN 18443]. *Chair's comments/corrections:* Revise description to read "Intensive research development and critical methods in digital humanities. Presentation of capstone project in written and oral form, under faculty supervision, with focus on digital humanities skills and concepts." *Secretary's comments/corrections:* Title abbreviation revised; be consistent with project hours/week and credit weight – proposal for LLCU 689 (3 cr.) had 3 hrs/wk of project; confirmation needed as to why the passing grade for the prerequisite course is higher than the norm of B-; if higher grade requested, indicate this in supplementary info box as a note to students; confirmation needed as to why the course activity/schedule type is not "Project" as per title; be consistent with the restriction wording – see rewrite for DHUM 620;
