**Committee on Enrolment and Student Affairs (CESA)**  
**2019-2020 Annual Report**

**Terms of Reference:**

1. The Committee shall review and recommend to Senate:
  - a. policies as they affect course timetabling, student records, and student affairs in general;
  - b. principles regarding sessional dates and specific sessional dates for all faculties and for the Centre for Continuing Education, including the beginning and end of the session, holidays, and examinations.
2. The Committee shall review and recommend to Senate, where appropriate in collaboration with the faculties and Academic Policy Committee:
  - a. policies related to academic integrity;
  - b. policies related to student advising and orientation.
3. The Committee shall review and approve in the name of Senate:
  - a. new awards and changes in the conditions of existing awards made by the University to its students; awards include scholarships, fellowships, prizes, medals, bursaries, loans, and the work-study program;
  - b. the admissions standards and policies of the University.
4. The Committee shall report annually to Senate about:
  - a. policy recommendations;
  - b. actions taken in the name of Senate;
  - c. awards and financial aid provided to McGill students.
5. The Committee shall strike a subcommittee with the Dean of Students as Chair that would make recommendations regarding procedures for review of admissions decisions and, as needed, review the application of such procedures in individual cases. The subcommittee shall report annually to the Committee.
6. The Committee shall meet at least three times during the academic year.

## Report on CESA Activities, 2019-2020

---

The Committee met on eight occasions, and held one email vote, with the following issues being addressed:

### 1. Policy recommendations

CESA did not make any policy recommendations in 2019-20.

### 2. Actions taken in the name of Senate

On behalf of Senate, CESA took the following actions:

#### a. Test Optional admission fall 2021 – US High School Applicants

Enrolment Services implemented standardized test optional admissions for fall 2021, and only for “A” faculties. The proposal is to be test optional for scholarship consideration as well. Any extension of test optional admissions for US High School applicants would be brought to CESA in a separate proposal before May 2021, and this, depending on the COVID 19 impact information for fall 2022 admissions available at that time.”

#### b. Undergraduate Dentistry Admission Specific Pathway for Indigenous Students

The Faculty of Dentistry implemented a Undergraduate Dentistry Admission Specific Pathway for Indigenous Students as follows:

Requirements:

- Be First Nations under the Indian Act (RSC, C1-5) or Inuit (registered in the Inuit client registry) and have confirmed status as a member of the First Nations or Inuit of Quebec; or
- Be registered to one of the Métis Registries recognized by the Métis National Council: Métis Nation of Ontario, Métis Nation of Alberta, Manitoba Metis Federation, Métis Nation British Columbia and Métis Nation – Saskatchewan.
- Be a Quebec resident (only DENT-P applicants);
- Declare your First Nations, Inuit or Métis status on your application form;
- Have a minimum R-score of 28 or more (for admission to Dent-P); or the equivalent CGPA (approximately 3.2/4.0) for admission to the DMD program.
- Meet all other general requirements for admission to the DMD program (university applicants) or Dent-P program (CEGEP applicants);
- Submit your application and required supporting documents by November 1 (university applicants) or March 1 (CEGEP applicants)

Required documentation:

- Applicants who wish to be considered for Indigenous reserved seats will be required to submit documentation to support their declaration of Indigenous ancestry. One of the following are considered acceptable:

- a certified copy of your Status card;
- a certified copy of your Metis membership card from one of the 5 recognized provincial organizations;
- your roll number or any other proof accepted by Inuit communities.
- Transcripts from every post-secondary institution and/or provide your permanent code if you are/were enrolled in CEGEP.
- Standardized Personal Statement

Selection Process:

If the application is retained after the 1st selection level (the evaluation of your academic file), applicants need to fulfill 3 other steps:

1. Individual interview (panel consisting of an Indigenous dentist, Indigenous community member and Admissions Committee members);
2. Review of the Standardized Personal Statement;
3. Multiple mini-interviews (MMI) in your preferred language (English or French).

The final selection is based on the results obtained during the 4 steps of the selection process in the following order:

1. Academic dossier (undergraduate cGPA): 25%
2. Individual Interview: 25%
3. Standardized Personal Statement: 25%
4. MMI results: 25%

**c. Revision to the Admissions Requirements to the Bachelor of Education and Masters of Arts in Teaching and Learning in the Faculty of Education**

The Faculty of Education added the requirement that applicants to the Bachelor of Education and Masters of Arts in Teaching and Learning take the CASPer test.

**d. Revisions to the Admissions Requirements for the Ingram School of Nursing**

The Ingram School of Nursing revised its French language requirements for admission as follows:

French proficiency will be defined as obtaining a level of 82 or higher on all of four components (i.e., listening, speaking, reading and writing) on any of the tests listed below. Proof of proficiency will be submitted by applicants to enrolment services along with their application. These tests are widely available, offered frequently, and at reasonable costs.

- TCF: Test de connaissance du français tout public,
- TCFQ: Test de connaissance du français pour le Québec,
- TCF OAP: Test de connaissance du français (pour la demande d'admission préalable dans une université de France),
- TEF (or the electronic version eTEF) : Test d'évaluation du français (pour les études en France),
- TEFaQ (or the electronic version) : Test d'évaluation du français pour l'accès au Québec,

- TEF Canada (or the electronic version) : Test d'évaluation du français Canada

Note that the TFI (Test de Français International) is excluded from this list because it does not provide information separately on each of the four areas of French competency needed by nursing students.

Exemptions to testing:

Secondary school equivalency

- Studied in French in a Quebec secondary school (secondary year 4 and 5).
- Studied in a bilingual program in a Quebec secondary school (secondary year 4 and 5) AND had above 75% average grade in French language classes.
- Studied the last two consecutive secondary years in a French-language high school.

CEGEP and pre-university experience

- Diploma of College Studies (DEC) delivered by a francophone CEGEP before the Épreuve uniforme in 1998.
- Épreuve uniforme de français langue d'enseignement et littérature (EULL) in CEGEP.
- Pre-university diploma from a French program outside of Canada where French is the main language of instruction (ie : Baccalauréat d'une académie de France, certificat d'enseignement secondaire supérieur de Belgique, Certificat de maturité de Suisse).

Certificates of French Proficiency

- Diplome Approfondi de Langue Française (DALF),
- McGill Certificate of Proficiency in French (SCS),
- McGill Certificate of Proficiency in French for Professional Communication (SCS) University equivalency,
- 60 credits in an undergraduate program full time in a francophone university in Quebec,
- At least 2 consecutive years in an undergraduate program full time fully in French in Canada or elsewhere.

#### **e. Approval of use of Duolingo English Test**

Enrolment Services introduced the use of the Duolingo English Test (DET) with a minimum score of 115/160 be approved as a proof of English proficiency for admission to undergraduate programs at McGill on a trial basis until January 2021.

#### **f. Revisions to the Admissions Requirements for the Commercial Cannabis Diploma**

*The Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences Department of Plant Science amended the Admission Requirements for the Commercial Cannabis Diploma from:*

Applicants for the Diploma are required to have a B.Sc. in biological, agricultural or environmental sciences, 15 credits of plant-related courses, a course in biochemistry or

organic chemistry, and a minimum CGPA of 3.0. Under exceptional circumstances, relevant work experience will be considered in lieu of plant courses,

to:

Applicants for the Diploma are required to have a Bachelor of Science, *ideally* in biological, environmental or agricultural sciences, including courses *relevant* to plant biology *and I ar food chemistry as well as* a course in biochemistry or organic chemistry, and a minimum CGPA of 3.0.

#### **g. Revisions to the Admissions Requirements for the School of Architecture**

The School of Architecture revised its admission requirements as follows:

All CEGEP concentrations, including the following courses:

- Two Math courses: Calculus and Linear Algebra
- One Physics: Mechanics
- One other science

Mature students would be required to have completed the equivalent of one-year general post-secondary education, including two math courses (Calculus and Linear Algebra) and two science courses (including Physics Mechanics).

University transfer students would be required to have completed (either in CEGEP or at University) two math courses (Calculus and Linear Algebra) and two science courses (including Physics Mechanics).

Recommended:

Studio-based Art classes and more general visual art classes.

#### **h. Revisions to the Admissions Requirements for the Schulich School of Music**

The Schulich School of Music removed prerequisite courses in the following programs:

Master of Music in Performance; Early Music  
M.Mus. Performance; Opera and Voice  
M.Mus. Performance; Organ  
M.Mus. Performance; Piano  
M.Mus. Performance; Collaborative Piano  
M.Mus. Performance; Conducting  
M.Mus. Performance; Jazz  
M.Mus. Performance; Orchestral Instruments, Guitar  
M.Mus. Music; Composition  
M.A. Music; Music Education



M.A. Music; Musicology  
M.A. Music; Musicology; Gender and Women's Studies  
M.A. Music; Music Theory  
M.A. Music; Music Theory; Gender and Women's Studies  
M.A. Music; Music Technology

Students enrolled in these programs will be required to successfully complete undergraduate courses before completion of their Master's degree.

### **3. Awards and financial aid provided to McGill students**

CESA approves new awards and changes in the conditions of existing awards made by the University to its students; awards include scholarships, fellowships, prizes, medals, bursaries, loans, and the work-study program. Approvals are classified into "template", meaning that they follow a set of guidelines established by the Committee in 2009 to expedite award approval. "Non-template" means that the Award terms are brought to the Committee meeting for a full discussion.

The following summarizes the activities of CESA, with regard to new and revised awards between September 1, 2019 and August 31, 2020. A listing of the Awards has been appended to this report for reference.

- New Non-Template awards approved: 12
- New awards conforming to an approved template: 79
- Revisions to awards conforming to an approved template: 33

### **Plans for 2019-2020**
