ACTION REQUIRED: INFORMATION APPROVAL/DECISION

ISSUE The Advisory Council on the Charter of Students' Rights is required to report annually to Senate.

BACKGROUND & RATIONALE Article 51 of the *Charter of Students' Rights* states:
The Council shall provide Senate annually with a report of its activities. This report shall include a summary of each investigation and its final outcome, but with any individual parties not identified by name. The report shall also include a summary of requests for which an investigation was denied.

Article 47.1 of the *Charter of Students' Rights* states:
The Council shall investigate any allegation that the general application of a University rule is in violation of this Charter. A request for investigation may be made by a member of the University (the complainant) or may be referred to the Council by the Committee on Student Grievances.

Since no issues were referred to the Council in accordance with Article 47.1 of the *Charter of Students' Rights*, it did not convene.
