#### MCGILL UNIVERSITY SENATE

Report of the Senate Steering Committee 18-19:03

(November 6, 2018 meeting, in preparation for Senate meeting of November 21, 2018)

#### 1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF SENATE

The minutes of the Senate meeting of October 24, 2018 were circulated to the Steering Committee, and the Steering Committee provided feedback. It is recommended that they now be considered by Senate for approval.

#### 2. APPROVAL OF CONFIDENTIAL MINUTES OF SENATE

The Steering Committee reports that it has reviewed the confidential minutes of the meeting of October 24, 2018 and has approved them on behalf of Senate. These minutes are not published or circulated but are available for perusal by Senators in the Secretariat.

#### 3. CONFIDENTIAL SESSION

The Steering Committee recommends that Senate hold a confidential session for discussion of item IIB11, Report of Honorary Degrees and Convocations Committee (D18-22).

#### 4. SPEAKING RIGHTS

The Steering Committee requests speaking rights for Professor Nancy Ross, Associate Vice-Principal (Research and Innovation), for item IIB4 (Strategic Research Plan 2019) and Dr. Cameron Charlebois, Executive Director, Campus Planning and Development, for item IIB6 (Annual Report of the Committee on Physical Development).

#### 5. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The Steering Committee has reviewed the Agenda for the present meeting and recommends it for approval.

#### 6. BREACH OF CONFIDENTIALITY

The Steering Committee was made aware of a recent breach of Senate confidentiality relating to a recommendation of the Honorary Degrees and Convocations Committee. The Steering Committee recommends referring this matter to the Committee on the Rights of Senate for investigation as divulging recommendations for the conferral of honorary degrees is a substantial interference with the performance of Senate's functions.

The Committee on the Rights of Senate studies every matter duly referred to it and reports its findings to Senate. It may recommend further actions, including temporary exclusion from Senate, expulsion from Senate, or the institution of disciplinary proceedings by the appropriate University bodies.

#### 7. REVIEW OF QUESTIONS AND MOTIONS

The Senate Steering Committee received a question from Senators Labonté and Wilson regarding Indigenous curriculum content and equitable recruitment, which was approved for submission to Senate. A response to the question will be provided by Senator Manfredi.

The Steering Committee also received a motion from Senator Dunn regarding the creation of a conference committee on divestment. The motion was deemed to be out of order and was not accepted for submission to Senate. It was noted that the establishment of a conference committee cannot be supported by the cited provision of the Statues (6.3.9) as the statutory conditions requiring a conference committee have not been met in this case.

However, the Committee acknowledged interest in Senate playing a more active role in the consultation process that CAMSR will be undertaking. As such, the Steering Committee asked the Senate Nominating Committee to recommend to Senate the appointment of Senate representatives who would take part in CAMSR's consultation process. This approach is supported by CAMSR. The recommendations of the Senate Nominating Committee will be presented to Senate as part of the Committee's report.

### 8. APPROVAL OF DEGREES, CERTIFICATES AND DIPLOMAS FOR FALL 2018 CONVOCATION

On October 24, 2018, in accordance with its Terms of Reference, the Steering Committee approved in the name of Senate, the degrees, certificates and diplomas listed in Appendix A (attached document) and empowered the Secretary of Senate to make changes to the lists as necessary.
