BACKGROUND:	The above-cited professional degree programs, <i>B.Sc.</i> (Occupational Therapy) and <i>B.Sc.</i> (Physical Therapy), were redesigned when the new professional master's programs, Master of Science, Applied, in Occupational Therapy and Master of Science, Applied, in Physical Therapy, were approved as the degree requirements for professional practice (approval by Senate on 4 <sup>th</sup> December 2002 and by the Ministry of Education, Leisure and Sport (MELS) on 2 <sup>nd</sup> November 2006.	
	The degree titles of the undergraduate programs including the words "Occupational Therapy" and "Physical Therapy" were deemed misleading to the public and to the students enrolled in the program. A new degree title was therefore established.	
	The old degree designations require deletion from the Statutes and the new
