(A) Exchange Agreements

Sibelius Academy of Finland - student exchange agreement with the Schulich School of Music

At its meeting on 31st August 2006 APPC approved an agreement for a Bilateral Student Exchange Program between Finland's Sibelius Academy and McGill's Schulich School of Music. Sibelius Academy is the only music university in Finland and the largest music school in Scandinavia. It boasts an enrolment of approximately 1700 students. In terms of international competition winners, the Academy qualifies as being among the top five music schools in the world (along with the *Hochschule der Künste* in Berlin, the Royal Academy of Music in London, Moscow Conservatory, and the Curtis Institute in Philadelphia). McGill will become the Academy's first Canadian partner and this will be McGill's first exchange agreement that is specific to the Schulich School of Music. McGill University currently has one general bilateral student exchange agreement with one other Finnish University, Tampere University of Technology. A special one-year agreement to attend the Academy this fall semester. At expiration, and consequent on a successful exchange, the Agreement would then be renewed for the full five-year term.

(B) Canadian Graduate Student Research Mobility Agreement (CGSRMA)

At its meeting on 11th May 2006 APPC approved a memorandum of understanding proposed by the Canadian Association for Graduate Studies to encourage graduate student mobility. It is a framework for student research exchanges that result predominantly from collaboration between researchers. By approving it, McGill has shown support of the concept of graduate student mobility within Canada.
