## 1. POLICY RELATING TO THE NAMING OF UNIVERSITY ASSETS

## 11. STUDENT RESIDENCE FEES 2006-2007

The student residence rates for 2006-2007 were approved, according to the following increases:

a) Downtown campus: 4.2% for undergraduate housing in all Halls: Bishop Mountain,

RVC, Douglas, Solin, and M.O.R.E.; and 1.6% increase for graduate housing;

# 12. STUDENTS' SOCIETY OF McGILL UNIVERSITY (SSMU)

The Executive Committee of the Board of Governors authorized the Provost and the Vice-Principal (Administration and Finance) to sign, on behalf of McGill University the Receipt, Release and Settlement agreement relating to the McGill Bookstore profits with the Students' Society of McGill University.

It further authorized the Vice-Principal (Administration and Finance) to sign the lease Agreement with the Students' Society of McGill University for a six-year period commencing June 1, 2005.

# 13. STUDENTS' SOCIETY OF MCGILL UNIVERSITY (SSMU) DAY CARE AGREEMENT OF LEASE

The Vice-Principal (Administration and Finance) and the Dean of Students were authorized by the Board of Governors to sign, on behalf of McGill University, the Day Care Lease Agreement with the Students' Society of McGill University, for a four-year period commencing June 1, 2005.

#### 14. PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH FISHER SCIENTIFIC LTD.

The Executive Committee of the Board of Governors authorized the Vice-Principal (Administration and Finance) to sign a purchase agreement relating to miscellaneous laboratory supplies and minor equipment with Fisher Scientific Ltd. effective November 1, 2005 for a three-year term with an option to renew for up to two additional twelve-month periods.
