ISSUE:	Amendment to the Code of Student Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures, Article 8: Physical Abuses, Harassment and Dangerous Activity
BACKGROUND:	The University has identified the need to address a broader range of potential cases of physical abuse, harassment and dangerous activity (e.g. hazing).
MOTION OR RESOLUTION	Be it resolved that article 8 of the Code of Student Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures be amended to read:
OR APPROVAL:	No student shall on property owned or occupied by the University, or in a University context:
	(a) Assault another person, including sexual assault, threaten any other another person <u>or persons</u> with bodily harm or damage to such person's property or knowingly, and without just cause, cause any other person to fear bodily harm or fear damage to his or her property ; or
	(b) Knowingly create a condition which unnecessarily endangers or threatens <u>or undermines</u> the health, safety <u>, or well-being, or dignity</u> of <u>an</u> other <u>person or</u> persons <u>, threatens to cause humiliation</u> or threatens the damage or destruction of property.
	(c) <u>Harass s</u> Sexually <u>or otherwise</u> harass another member of the University community (see " <u>Policy on Harassment, Sexual Harassment and</u> <u>Discrimination Prohibited by Law</u> Regulations Concerning Complaints of Sexual Harassment ", for definition and procedures, especially articles 1.1 to 1.5 and 7 .2).

RATIONALE:	Wording has been simplified so that the meaning is clearer to all readers.
PRIOR CONSULTATION:	A Working group to develop a policy on hazing and inappropriate initiation practices, chaired by the Dean of Students, was struck by the Provost during the 2005-06 academic year. Their recommendations included a revision to this article which was discussed and approved for submission to Senate at CSA's October 4, 2006 meeting.
NEXT STEPS:	Senate approval.
