McGill University Research Centre for Physical Activity and Health (Appendix A)

At a meeting on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2012, APC reviewed and approved a proposal from the Faculty of Education to create the McGill University Research Centre for Physical Activity and Health. The Centre is to be located in the Department of Kinesiology and Physical Education and the Faculty of Education is to be its lead faculty. The mandate of the Centre is to conduct research of the highest calibre which addresses fundamental questions related to physical activity and health and to apply the insights gained from basic research in addressing health issues of national and global concern. The Research Advisory Committee reviewed the proposal in light of the University's Research Centre Regulations and Research Centre Proposal Template (2005) and approved the proposal at its meeting on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2011.

APC therefore recommends that Senate approve the following resolution:

Be it resolved that Senate approve the proposal for the creation of the McGill University Research Centre for Physical Activity and Health / Centre universitaire de recherche en activité physique et santé McGill, and so recommend to the Board of Governors.

The new title of this Specialization is intended to be simple, accessible, and more representative of the courses. The name change reflects the revisions made to the program: three fewer required credits and three more complementary credits; both lists of complementary courses have been reworked and expanded to include more offerings. A new, expanded program description has also been approved. The proposed revisions and name change were previously approved by SCTP on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2012.
