
- McGill's Strategic Academic Plan (2017-2022) commits the University to several enrolment targets as part of its key objectives. We are working to:

  - Maintain international student enrolment at 25-30% of the total undergraduate population; and
  - Continue to attract top graduate students from around the world.












Indigenous student enrolment, excluding OFNIE

Total number of countries represented by **International** students



#### Doctoral new registrations: International and domestic students





## Total enrolment by Level of Study



# Undergraduate enrolment by Level of Study


