### 1. Introductions and Updates:

### Blog:

- -SIS questionnaire received 17 replies. Trying to up visibility.
- -Dr. Cook Dean of Libraries was interviewed by Justin; article will go up on website

#### Bank Account:

- -We got control of bank account, and received money from PGSS.
- -Considering changing from CIBC to a different bank to avoid monthly charges

### Website:

- -New MLISSA website is running
- -Facebook page wasn't active in past year; maybe hard to spur interest in it now. Need to look into regaining admin rights to the page. We will try to have it ready next year at the beginning of the school year
- -In the meantime, we will direct people who go to the Facebook page to go to the MLISSA blog and MLISSA web page

### MLIS I Curriculum:

- -Will talk to people about their views on core and stream classes.
- Different Universities' programs have varying levels of technical instruction

#### MLIS II Curriculum:

- -Restructuring of committees occurred at the retreat.
- -The curriculum will be restructured, but no update yet about the details

#### Ph. D Rep:

-Position is still open

#### **Elections:**

- -In January, we will have bids for new positions, and people will be elected by the end of January
- -8 positions will be open. Once filled, they won't be active until the Fall, but will still be part of MLISSA.
- -Important to meet with replacements before the school year is over

#### 2. Student Life Fund:

- -Grad Student Associations were restructured, and there is a new fund through PGSS
- -Talked to Heather, President of Education Student Society, and we agreed that it is better to keep things the way they are (SIS will remain separate from EGSS).
- We currently receive \$3500 for SIS. Even if we receive slightly less money than we would if we joined EGSS, it is worth it to keep our autonomy
- -We can still apply to EGSS's conference grants

## Funding for other SIS Student Groups:

- -MLISSA represents best interests of all students, so we need to decide how to allocate funding to other student groups
- -Look at past financials to determine how much was given to each student group
- -Last year, CLA McGill received funding from MLISSA because the parent organization was being restructured, and they didn't receive any money from them
- -Crate a policy for accepting applications based on past experiences

### End-of-term Party:

- -December 14, at SIS Mansion, at 6-9. MLISSA will pay for finger food, SIS will bring wine.
- We need to know how many people are attending, by December 2, to determine quantity of wine
- -Sarah will go to Costco. We will ask students to bake goods.
