- **Accompagner et soutenir les couples immigrants en processus d'intégration (16 avril 2014)**

Le projet migratoire des couples et des familles recèle souvent l'espoir de se donner de meilleures conditions de vie et possibilités d'avenir. Cependant, intégrer une nouvelle culture modifie considérablement les rapports de couple et l'organisation familiale. Chacun doit réinventer la façon d'incarner son rôle, dans un contexte social, économique et culturel différent. Les partenaires peuvent avoir de la difficulté à cheminer au même rythme et conserver l'équilibre du couple. Certaines blessures du passé peuvent également ressurgir. Tout ce processus de changement peut générer des tensions entre les partenaires et mettre à risque la relation conjugale et familiale. Dans ce contexte, soutenir le couple en période de transition et d'ajustement permet de mettre en lumière les perspectives de chacun et miser sur les forces de la relation, de manière préventive. Comment peut-on offrir des services aux couples dans nos différentes ressources? Quelle approche préconiser pour favoriser la participation du couple et de la famille pour le mieux-être de chacun?

• **2014 Mattinson Scholarship Program for Students with Disabilities**

Objective: To encourage Canadian students with permanent disabilities to pursue university studies with the ultimate objective of obtaining a first undergraduate degree.

Deadline: Postmarked paper application must be sent to the AUCC no later than **MAY 15, 2014**.

Number of Awards

- Up to six (6) scholarships, distributed as follows:
 - 1 in the category of *Physical Disability*;
 - 1 in the category of *Sensory Disability*;
 - 1 in the category of *Mental Health Disability*;
 - 1 in the category of *Learning Disability*;
 - 2 in any of the previously listed categories.

Requirements for eligibility

Eligible applicants must:

- be Canadian citizens or permanent residents who have lived in Canada for minimum 2 years;
- be diagnosed with a permanent disability which is documented and is the primary disability for which they are applying.

Value: \$2,500 CAD for a bachelor degree program, tenable for one academic year.

- **Wolfe Graduate Fellowship**

The mandate of the Wolfe Chair is to conduct research, teach and perform public outreach regarding the intellectual foundations, nature and methods of scientific and technological innovation and to provide support to well-rounded students capable of making constructive contributions to debates surrounding science, technology and society. The Chair is devoted to research that advances understanding of key scientific and technological concepts and examines the relationships among science, technology, and a broad range of social, ethical, political, and economic issues, practices and conditions.

We are seeking outstanding graduate students in the Faculty of Arts conducting research in areas directly related to the themes of the Wolfe Chair and preferably who will be writing their thesis or dissertation during the 2014-2015 academic year (preference will be given to PhD students during their final year of the program). These fellowships (valued at \$8000) will be awarded on the basis of high academic standing, community involvement, and athletic activities. Students must be registered as full-time graduate students during the 2014-2015 academic year to receive funds.

Applications should include a completed form ([2014-2015_wolfe_fellowship_application.pdf](#)), curriculum vitae, and a letter of support from your thesis supervisor.
