1) SEMINARS

Comparative Social Policy and Rights-Based Community Practice Seminar

1 day per week, can apply towards 3-credits (1 course)

Taught by Professor Jim Torczyner, McGill University School of Social Work

2) FIELD WORK

Placements in at MMEP community center with local supervision

3 days per week (with field visits, approximately 300 hours total) with local supervision

Combined with field visits, can apply for credit as internship or field practicum

3) FIELD VISITS:

1 day per week to leading practice sites related to policy and practice issues

ELIGIBILITY:

Upper-class undergraduate students and Graduate students

Students from any department with an interest in rights-based community practice

(eg. Social Work, International Development, Political Science, Women's Studies, etc.)
