**Keynote Speaker**



**Felicia Guarna** is the Director of Rehabilitation for the Centre intégré universitaire de santé et de services sociaux (CIUSSS) du Centre-Ouest-de-l’Île-de-Montréal. She is responsible for rehabilitation services within short-stay institutions, CLSCs, intermediate resources and transition units for functional recuperation. She also oversees physical disability programs, as well as teams working with patients who have intellectual disabilities and autism. Ms. Guarna held management positions in a number of rehabilitation organizations. Most recently, she served as Director of Rehabilitation at CSSS Cavendish.
