

EXEMPTION REQUEST FORM IPEA 500 Roles in Interprofessional Teams and/or

IPEA 501 Communication in Interprofessional Teams. School of Physical and Occupational Therapy Qualifying OT and Qualifying PT Students

IPEA courses are mandatory for all students in the OTQY and PT QY programs in the Professional Masters' programs. Exemptions are possible for IPEA 500 Roles in Interprofessional Teams and IPEA 501 Communication in Interprofessional Teams.

NB: No exemptions are possible for IPEA 502 Patient-Centred Care in Action or IPEA 503 Managing Interprofessional Conflict as these courses require advanced application and integration of the IPE competencies to achieve the goal of team collaboration.

Courses completed at McGill:

If you successfully completed IPEA 500 or IPEA 501 during the 2014-2015 academic year or afterward while registered in another health professions program at McGill, you are not expected to repeat these courses. Contact Marlene Brettler (profmasters.spot@mcgill.ca) to ensure that the exemption(s) appear on your transcript no later than the first day of Fall term courses. Courses completed at a university other than McGill (External Courses):

For both IPEA 500 and IPEA 501 requests, if you successfully completed similar courses at a university other than McGill, please submit this form as well as your course outline(s) or documentation of the courses taken to the Office of Interprofessional Education (OIPE) at the following address: ipecourses.med@mcgill.ca.

Submission Deadline:

Documents, including this form must be submitted by July 31.

For students admitted after July 15, documents must be submitted by the first day of fall classes for both IPEA 500 and IPEA 501 requests.

The Office of Interprofessional Education (OIPE) will decide if the course(s) are deemed equivalent. If they are, the OIPE will submit a letter on your behalf to the Director of the Physical Therapy program, and the Senior Administrative and Student Affairs Coordinator.
