CHEAP EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

McGill Events

- •Spirituality and wellness events: Check out the <u>weekly calendar</u> from the McGill Office of Religious and Spiritual Life.
- •Residences: Some McGill residences host events over the holidays ask your Floor Fellows/Dons and Residence Life Facilitators.
- <u>Winter Break Club</u>, hosted by International Student Services. Registration required. Free event.
- •Visit the <u>Student Services calendar</u> for a daily listing of events.



Entertainment

- •<u>Luminothérapie</u> takes place from November 30, 2023, to March 10, 2024. Illuminating <u>Place des Festivals</u> with a light installation, Luminothérapie is an antidote to Montreal's shortest and darkest days of the year.
- •Noël Dans le Parc takes place from December 8 to December 31, 2023 at three locations: Place Émilie Gamelin, Parc des Compagnons-du-Saint-Laurent, Parc Lahaie. Check out the New Year's Eve activities taking place at Place Émilie Gamelin.
- •<u>Santa's Kingdom</u> (Complexe Desjardins) for students with children and the young at heart. It takes place from November 25 to December 24, 2023.
- •National Film Board of Canada (NFB) has a wide range of films, documentaries, and animation available to stream for free. There is also interactive and educational content.

Exhibitions & Markets

- •The Great Christmas Market: November 25 to December 30, 2023 at the Quartier des spectacles.
- Montreal Vegan Christmas Market: Online, from December 2 to December 3, 2023. Free admission.
- <u>Jean Talon Christmas Market</u>: Enjoy food and local crafts at the legendary holiday edition of the Jean Talon Market.
- •Sainte-Anne Winter Market: (St-George's Anglican Church, 23 rue Perrault) The winter market takes place on Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. until December 23, 2023, then back on January 13, 2024.
- •Montreal Christmas Village: The most magical of Montreal's Christmas markets returns to the vicinity of Atwater Market. Open from November 30 to December 24, 2023, Friday evenings, and weekends. Free activities on site.



Winter Sports & Recreational Activities

Free Skating

<u>Visit outdoor skating rinks</u>. Skate rental is available at some rinks (\$) including Park La Fontaine and Parc Maisonneuve.

Skating, snow tubing, snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing at Mount Royal.

Visit Mount Royal Programming for details.

Visit your local park for winter activities, such as walking, sledding, snowshoeing, or cross-country skiing.

Here are a few suggestions:

- •Mont-Royal: bring your own sled to the East side of the mountain bordering Avenue du Parc
- Parc Jarry
- ·Cap St. Jacques
- •Parc nature Bois de Liesse: bring your own sled or rent one (\$5 to \$10)

Around Mac Campus:

- •Skating rinks in Ste-Anne-de-Bellevue, including Parc Harpell, Parc Aumais, and Parc Godin in Ste-Anne-de-Bellevue, or the indoor rink at the Mac Arena (free for students with a valid McGill ID, Monday Friday, 12pm 1pm! Check out their calendar and bring your skates!)
- •Morgan Arboretum has plenty of trails for walking, tobogganing, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing (there is a daily fee of \$9 for snowshoeing and skiing). Parking may be limited and entrance restricted to members only during peak times, so be sure to call ahead 514-398-7811.
- •Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing rentals from McGill Macdonald Athletics: Free snowshoe rentals if returned on the same day (McGill ID card required). Winter break special: \$35 to rent skis, boots, and poles for the week.
- •<u>Mac Fitness Centre/Gym</u>: Free for McGill students. Bring your McGill ID card. Check their website for opening and holiday hours.

Note: Equipment rentals and activity availability may vary according to public health measures. Check the <u>City of Montreal</u> website where you can search for information by borough.

CHEAP EATS

Generally, restaurants and grocery stores may be closed on December 25 and January 1 and may have reduced hours on December 24, 26 and/or 31. Check their opening hours online before you go!

Restaurants

Cosmos Snack Bar

5843 rue Sherbrooke Ouest

A solid option for when you're starving, or just craving some good greasy-spoon fare. They're famous for creations like breakfast burgers, and 6 egg omelets. Breakfast will likely run you less than \$10! Open during regular business hours throughout the holidays.

Cachitos

3 rue Sainte-Catherine ouest

Sells Venezuelan cachitos (bread with a variety of fillings), pastries, and coffee.

Bao Bao Dim Sum

83 rue de la Gauchetière Ouest

Similar to Cocobun but cheaper and yummier (in this humble writer's opinion at least). Located in Chinatown, it's worth the trip for it's beautiful location and proximity to other cheap eats! Some favourites: mixed vegetable steamed buns (\$3) and red bean steamed buns (\$3.50 to \$5.00). Open during regular business hours throughout the holidays.

Joe's Panini

1404 rue Drummond

The Super Sandwich of Concordia University. Open 24 hours, they offer a variety of sweet and savoury grilled sandwiches for \$8 to help you with those hungry all-nighters!

Pushap Restaurant and Sweet Shop

5195 rue Paré

Available for pick up and delivery, the people who make all the samosas for McGill fundraisers (known as "Samosa Gods") have a physical location, and it is filled with affordable Indian food. Their menu is vegetarian (with quite a few vegan options) and most single portion options are under \$7. Open 11:30 am-9 pm, but hours may vary during the holiday season.

Tim Hortons

674 rue Sherbrooke Ouest or 104 Boul. Don-Quichotte (near the Macdonald Campus)

A Canadian legend. They offer cheap coffee, hot drinks, donuts, and sandwiches. You can't walk 3 blocks in any Canadian city without passing one. They're reliable, everywhere, and open 24/7.
