Code of Conduct for Education Loans	<p>The US code of conduct stipulates the following: In order to prohibit a conflict of interest when it comes to private education loans, employees with responsibility for US loans are prohibited from the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Making revenue-sharing arrangements with any lender;- Receiving gifts from a lender, a guarantor, or a loan servicer;- Entering into arrangements providing financial benefit from any lender or affiliate of a lender;- Directing borrowers to particular lenders* or refusing or delaying loan certifications;- Offering funds for private loans;- All agents with responsibility for US loans are reminded at least annually of the code.
