FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE CONFLICTS

The usual exam conflict rules apply but with modification to account for the time that you will have to write take-home exams or timed exams. Many take-home exams will have a longer timeline (e.g., 48-hour window) for completion, which will allow you the flexibility to arrange your time to write the exam within the allotted time window. If your take-home exam overlaps with an exam that has now changed to a timed exam, this is not considered a conflict as you will have the flexibility to use the allotted time to write your take-home exam, allowing you to resolve any conflicts in your schedule.

If you have more than three (3) exams scheduled to be completed in a 48-hour period, this may constitute an exam conflict.

Should you have an exam schedule conflict, <u>you will be notified by the Exams Office</u>. If you have an exam scheduling conflict and have not received an email from the Exams Office, you must submit a **Final Exam Conflict Form** available at <u>www.mcgill.ca/summer/finalexams</u> to McGill Summer Studies <u>no later</u> than 5 working days prior to the exam. You will be informed by Summer Studies of the exact time and location of your rescheduled exam. Conflict exams are normally written on the same day in a room set aside for such exams.

REQUEST FOR DEFERRAL

Students who have been unable to write one or more examinations for serious reasons such as illness or family affliction may request permission to defer their examination. Students should be aware that deferred examinations are granted only for compelling reasons. Supporting evidence such as an appropriate medical report is required. <u>Vacation plans do NOT constitute grounds for re-scheduling or deferring a final examination.</u>

Deferral requests for final exams missed during the summer term should be submitted through Minerva. Deferred exams will be held August 14th- August 18th, concurrent with exams deferred from the Winter term. The deferral module on Minerva will be open from May 31st – August 9th, 2023.
