Dr. Alfred Turner Bazin, MD

Alfred Turner Bazin graduated from McGill in 1894. For the next 4 years he was member of the MGH house staff, rising to the post of medical superintendent. In 1912 he was appointed attending surgeon at the Montreal General and was secretary of the hospitals medical board and then chairman from 1923-1930. His first appointment at the McGill medical faculty was as a demonstrator of anatomy. He continued with that appointment through the 1907-1908 session and resigned when he was appointed demonstrator of clinical surgery for the 1908-1909 session. He Rose to become professor of surgery at McGill in 1924 and chairman of the McGill department of Surgery in 1937-1938.
