PROFESSOR NEIL SMART

PROFESSOR NEIL SMART is an Academic Colorectal Surgeon at the Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital in the United Kingdom. He is currently an Honorary Associate Professor at the University of Exeter Medical School where he has developed collaborative translational research projects with basic scientists which have enabled Exeter to become one of the largest contributors to multicentre trainee collaborative studies. He co-runs the Exeter Surgical Health Services Research Unit, an active research programme where he supervises surgical research fellows and UEMSS students producing numerous publications in peer-reviewed journals, culminating in presentations at national and international meetings. He sits on the Data Monitoring and Trial Steering Committee of several NIHR studies.

His clinical interests include rectal cancer, hernia prophylaxis, incisional hernia repair, abdominal wall reconstruction and parastomal hernias. He is chief investigator of the NIHR funded CIPHER study on parastomal hernia and a specialty advisor to NICE for mesh and stomas.

His interest in teaching and training surgical learners has led him to become an external examiner for doctoral theses at several universities in the UK and internationally. He is a clinical supervisor to surgical trainees at various levels at the Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital. He is an Affiliate of the Faculty of Surgical Trainers of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh.

He is active in medical publishing, providing peer review for over a dozen surgical journals as well as peer review of grant submissions for NIHR, MRC and AMRC affiliated bodies. Since 2019 he has served as the Editor-in-Chief of Colorectal Disease, the official journal of the ACPGIB, ESCP, AECP and MSCRS.

PHILIP H. GORDON, MD, FRCSC, FACS

PROFESSOR OF SURGERY AND ONCOLOGY MCGILL UNIVERSITY

DR. GORDON was the 1st Director of Colorectal Surgery at the Jewish General Hospital from 1974-2012.

Having completed a Colorectal Fellowship at the University of Minnesota, he returned to the Jewish General Hospital after serving as an honorary assistant in surgery at St. Mark's Hospital in London.

He was the first fully trained Colorectal Surgeon in Canada who devoted his surgical practice solely to Colorectal Surgery.

He was the founding President of the Canadian Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons from 1982-1986 and was the only non-American to serve as President of the American Society of Colon and Rectal Surgeons in 1994.

He co-authored several textbooks on Colorectal Surgery, which have served as references in the field. He served on numerous editorial boards of prestigious peer-reviewed journals, and co-authored numerous articles in peer-reviewed journals and textbooks. He became an honorary member of the Royal Society of Medicine Section of Coloproctology and the Association of Coloproctology of Great Britain and Ireland. He was named to the Faculty Honour List for Educational Excellence in recognition of contributions to teaching in the McGill Faculty of Medicine in 2007.

This lecture was established in recognition of Dr. Gordon's life-long devotion and contributions to Colorectal Surgery locally, nationally and internationally.
