Dr. Mulder was recruited as a post-military surgeon.

It was Dr. Rocke Roberts who passed on his passion. He did his training from 1963 to 1967 and specialized in

traumatology. He earned a Master of Science degree from McGill University in 1964.

Dr. Mulder was a leader in traumatology and Chief Surgeon at the Montreal General Hospital. He has been involved with the McGill Sports Medicine Centre since 1994.

Dr. Mulder has been associated with the Canadiens organization since 1963, when he began his career as an assistant to Dr. Douglas Kinnear with the Montreal Junior Canadiens, the Montreal Voyageurs, and then the Montreal Canadiens.

Dr. Mulder served as President of the NHL Team Physicians Society from 2003 to 2006. Dr. Mulder received the Order of Canada, and the Award of Merit from the Montreal General Hospital. In October 2012, he was awarded the USA National Safety Council Award for his role in developing a province wide trauma system in Quebec.
