

McGill Carbon Offsetting Program

Contributing to the Bayano-McGill Reforestation Project

Step 1: Use a carbon calculator to estimate your event's greenhouse gas emissions related to travel. To estimate travel-related emissions, use the "Estimated Travel Emissions" tab in the <u>Sustainable Event</u> Certification checklist.

Step 2: Decide how much you want to contribute. The suggested contribution for the Bayano-McGill Reforestation Project is \$35–65/tonne. There is a suggested price range because the project aims to cover the true cost of reforestation—from seedlings to salaries—so the exact price per tonne is not predetermined. Most reputable offsets currently cost about \$35/tonne, while Canada's <u>federal price on carbon pollution</u> is \$65/tonne as of 2023.

Step 3: Send us an email. Use the text below to <u>send us an email</u> that contains the information we need, including a brief description of your project, the attached emissions calculations, and your contribution amount. Feel free to ask us any questions you might have about the project or calculator.
