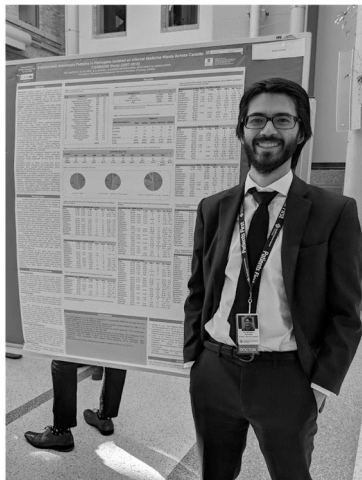

## Claire Trudel

After completing her medical and internal medicine training at the University of Sherbrooke, Claire Trudel pursued her specialty training in respirology at the Université de Montréal. Following this, she undertook a one-year fellowship in respiratory research, concentrating on the care of patients with tuberculosis and NTM pulmonary disease. Currently, she serves as an assistant professor at Hospital Sacre-Coeur de Montreal, affiliated with the Université de Montreal faculty of medicine. In her upcoming role, she will be the site Principal Investigator at Hospital Sacre-Coeur for Dr. Menzies' future Randomized Controlled Trial for latent TB treatment.



## Michael Onotera

Having completed his medical school training, internal medicine residency, and respirology fellowship at the University of Manitoba, he pursued a one-year fellowship in tuberculosis and nontuberculous mycobacteria within the infectious diseases section at McGill University. Alongside wrapping up various research endeavors at McGill, he is actively involved in Dr. Menzies' forthcoming Randomized Controlled Trial for latent TB as the Winnipeg Principal Investigator. Additionally, he is dedicated to establishing a prospective TB database in Winnipeg.
