## "Achieving equity and patient-centeredness in TB diagnostic services."

Courtney Yuen, PhD, is an epidemiologist and Assistant Professor in the Department of Global Health and Social Medicine at Harvard Medical School and the Division of Global Health Equity at Brigham and Women's Hospital. She is also Associate Director for Implementation Science at the Harvard University Center for AIDS Research.
