Her work has appeared in The Guardian, Narratively, The Forward, Lit Hub, Writers Digest, Dame Magazine, The Rumpus, and other publications.

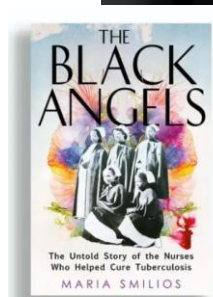
The Black Angels: The Untold Story of the Nurses Who Helped Cure Tuberculosis is her first book.
